

Attendance at Ethylene Producers' Committee annual Speakers' Dinner

The EPC hosts a Speakers' Dinner as part of the annual conference, recognizing speakers and Session Chairs for their contribution to the ethylene community. The EPC Program Co-Chair is responsible for arranging the event.

Attendance at the dinner is by invitation only. The EPC Program Co-Chair issues invitations, following guidance from the Committee. Invitation, in priority order, is limited to:

- Ethylene Producers' Committee members
- Podium Presenters¹
- Session Chairs and Co-Chairs
- Session Panelists
- EPC Keynote Speaker
- Spouses² of the above
- Key AIChE Programming & Meeting staff
- Spouses of EPC members
- Past members of the Ethylene Producers' Committee

Notes:

1. Papers often have multiple authors. Only those presenting at the session podium are invited to the Speaker's Dinner, with the maximum number of speakers per paper limited to two. Presenters are identified in Confex, the conference database.
2. Invitation may be extended to spouses, but other guests (business colleagues, friends, etc.) cannot be accommodated.
3. The Committee may further limit invitations to the Speakers' Dinner based on budget or event space limitations.
4. The EPC Program Chair and Program Co-Chair may use their discretion in special circumstances. These special circumstances will be reviewed with the Committee at the following EPC meeting.
