

#### INVESTING FOR NOW AND THE FUTURE

John Russo of Charles Schwab presented two perspectives on investing. The first presentation covered **Investing Strategies in Retirement.** The second presentation covered **Investing for Retirement.** The highlights of both presentations are summarized below.

#### **Investing Strategies in Retirement**

John handed out a packet entitled "Investing Strategies in Retirement." Copies of the packet are available from **Tom Flynn.** They are available on a first come first serve basis. He covered five general areas.

- Saving vs Investing
- Allocation
- Balancing the portfolio
- Adjusting portfolio over time
- Help and advice through Schwab

Average life expectancies of men and women are increasing.

Men/Women	Investment years
83/86	28+
83/86	23+
85/87	15+

Therefore, even when retired one needs to think about the long term. Retired investors are characteristically too conservative. Approximately 66% of retired people work part time.

He recommends setting aside 3-6 months living expenses. Establish two types of budgets.

- Comfort-level budget spend as you prefer without sacrifice
- Safety-level budget spend when pinching pennies is necessary for example during prolonged illness.

Current #1 concern is being able to cover health care expenses. Previously, the #1 concern was to leave something for the kids.

Need to have approximately \$230,000 invested to net \$1,000/year income. When to take social security is an issue.

- 65 is full retirement
- 62 80% of value if 65
- 120% of value at 65

After the basics are take care of consider using an index fund for simple diversification. Make changes in tax deferred accounts first and use dividends to rebalance. Retirees should stick to individual bonds vs bond funds because you won't lose the principle. Use bond ladders with staggered maturity dates to make effective use of bonds.

#### **Investing for Retirement**

John handed out packet entitled "Navigating Today's Market."

We are experiencing a volatile investment period. Since NASDAQ inception in 1971, 83% of 30 most volatile days have occurred in the last 5 years; 70% in 2000 alone. In the S&P 500, 30% of most volatile days have occurred in last 5 years, but only 10% in 2000. Recession is characterized by two consecutive quarters of negative GDP. He presented some general trends. Remember these when developing an investment strategy.

- A typical bull market lasts 28 months.
   A typical bear market lasts about 11 months. Value funds usually perform better than growth funds.
- Growth funds affected by changes in interest rates more quickly.
- Limit single holding to <30%.
- Value beats growth over the long run.
- Every change in interest rate by the Fed takes 6 months to take affect.
- 80% of fund managers do not beat the S&P 500 index fund, so have some in your portfolio.
