**Aim of the meeting:**

The IPCC Working Group III's (WG III) Expert Review Meeting follows the compilation of the First Order Draft (FOD) of WG III's contribution to the 5<sup>th</sup> Assessment Report (AR5) and takes place within the first Expert Review period.

The meeting brings together WG III AR5 Coordinating Lead Authors (CLAs) and Expert Reviewers largely from the business and NGO communities to discuss the FOD. The aim of the Expert Review Meeting is to:

1. foster critical analysis of the WG III AR5 FOD text;
2. increase understanding on the nature of comments, facilitating the Expert Review process of the WG III AR5 FOD;
3. provide additional insights into topics covered in the AR5 to ensure balance in the text of subsequent drafts; and
4. identify and gain access to additional literature, to which ready access might not be otherwise available.

**Meeting Deliverables:**

The Expert Review Meeting builds on the successful processes in the 4<sup>th</sup> Assessment Report and is expected to tangibly improve the Expert Review process of the AR5. A short report will be written containing a brief summary of the discussions and comments received during the Expert Review Meeting. This report will be input to the Third Lead Author Meeting to be held in Vigo, Spain on November 5-9<sup>th</sup>, 2012 as a supplement the official FOD expert review comments.

**Meeting Input:**

After registration experts will receive a personalized email with login details and instructions to access the FOD for the period of 20 July - 14 September, 2012. On the FOD download page, reviewers can also find a template into which written comments can be inserted as a part of the formal Expert Review.

**Structure:**

The meeting lasts 3 days and consists of a series of plenary presentations (WG III AR5 CLAs and invited guest speakers), a series of break-out groups (BOGs) and chapter booth (i.e. poster) sessions during which invited experts can speak one-on-one with WG III AR5 CLAs to provide chapter specific feedback.

The purpose of the plenary sessions is two-fold: 1) To give invited guests a brief overview of the content of the chapters and X-cuts; and 2) To discuss in a larger group, over-arching topics relevant across chapters.

BOG and chapter booth sessions aim to allow intimate, focused discussion on specifics of the AR5 WG III chapters and X-cuts. Each BOG will begin with one invited expert (informed in advance of the meeting) providing a ~10 minute feed-back on the chapter or X-cut to facilitate discussion. CLAs will moderate the session, supported by the Expert Review Meeting Steering Committee members and the WG III Technical Support Unit. It will be the aim of each BOG session to answer the following questions:

- ◇ How can the WG III AR5 improve the way issues are presented?
- ◇ Where are the gaps in knowledge in the WG III AR5?

The meeting concludes with a panel discussion of the Steering Committee on the implication of the meetings discussions for the subsequent WG III AR5 draft.
