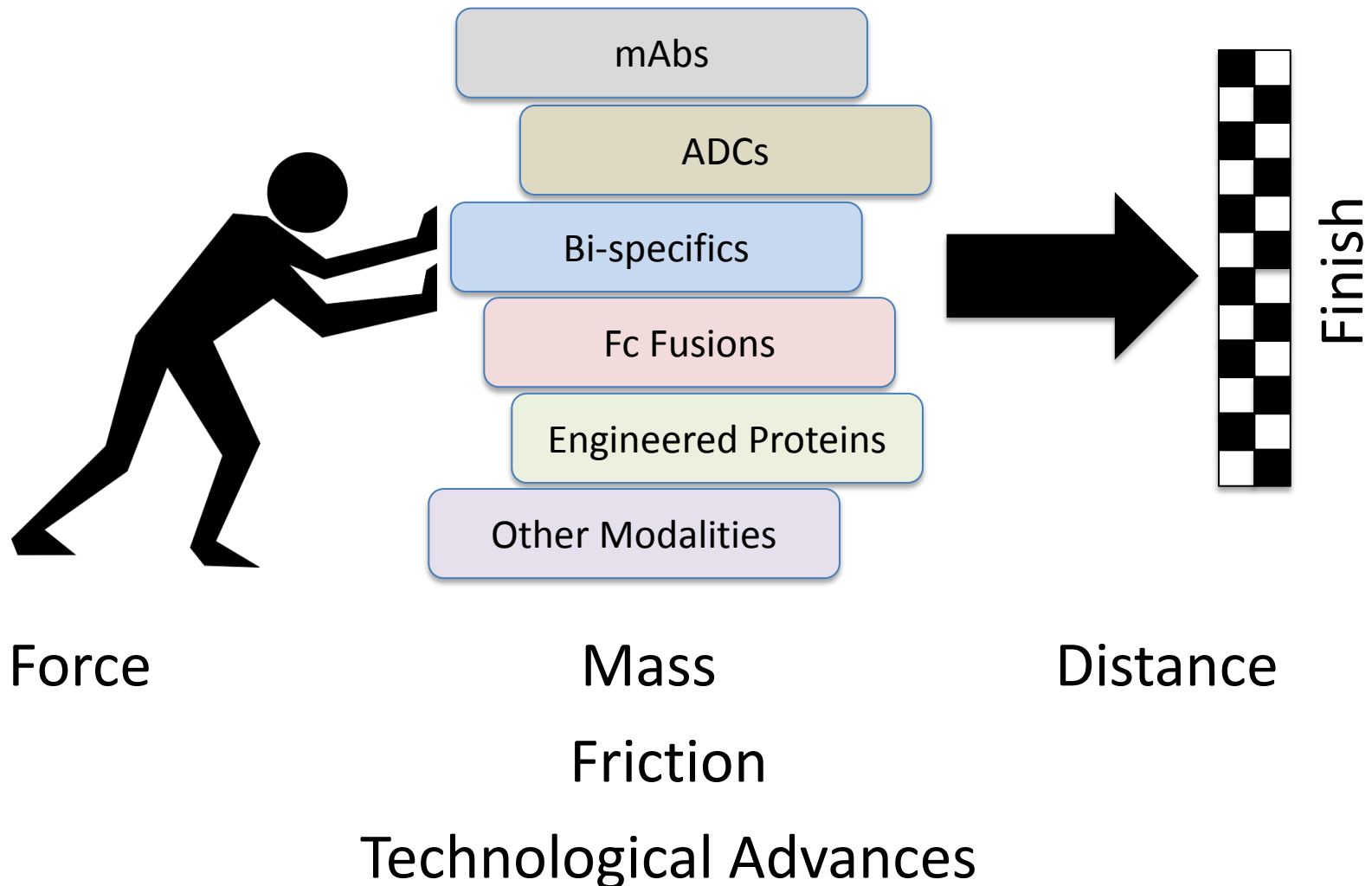

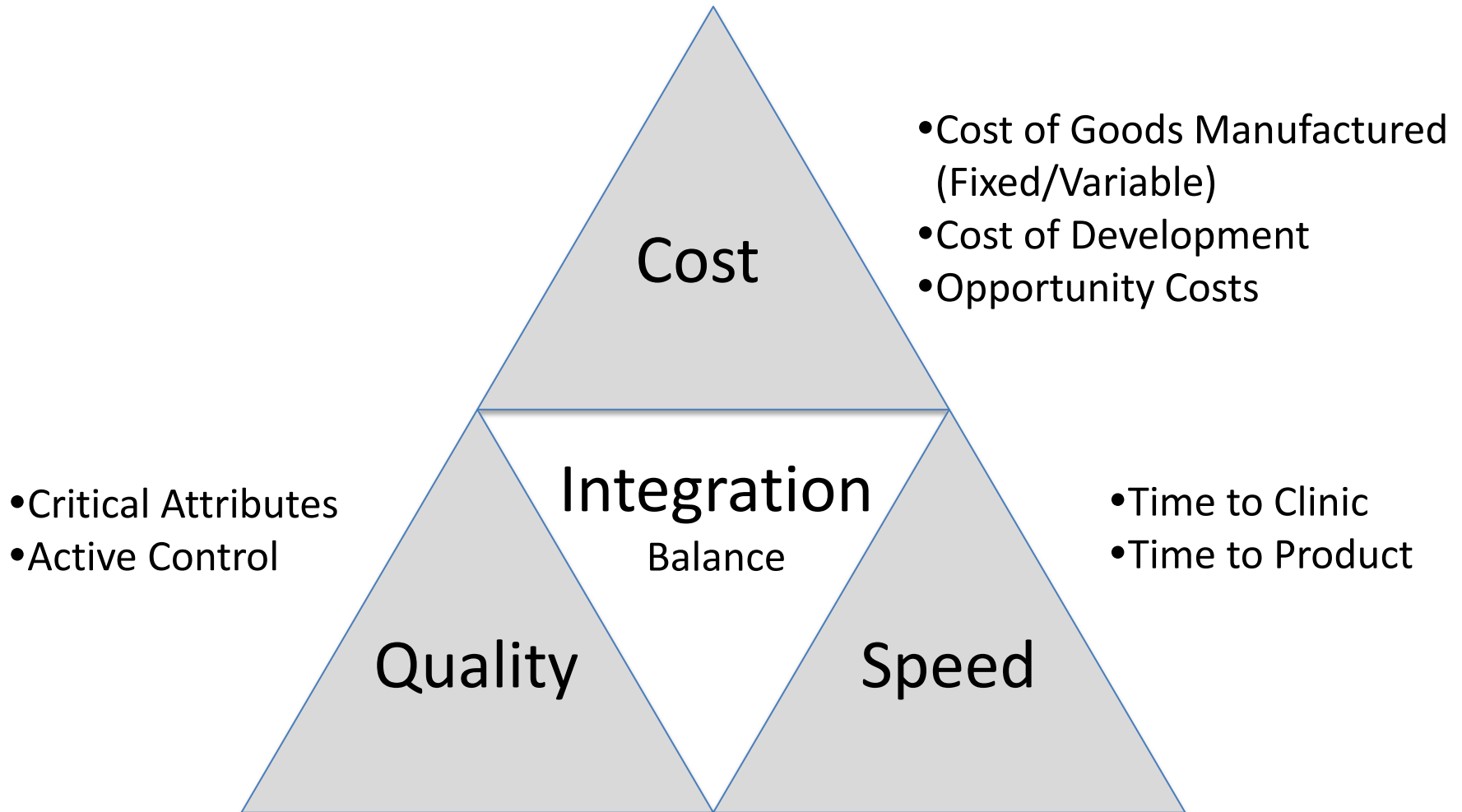
# Cross-Functional Teams Drive Product Development



# What Levers Have We Been Working With to Accelerate Development?

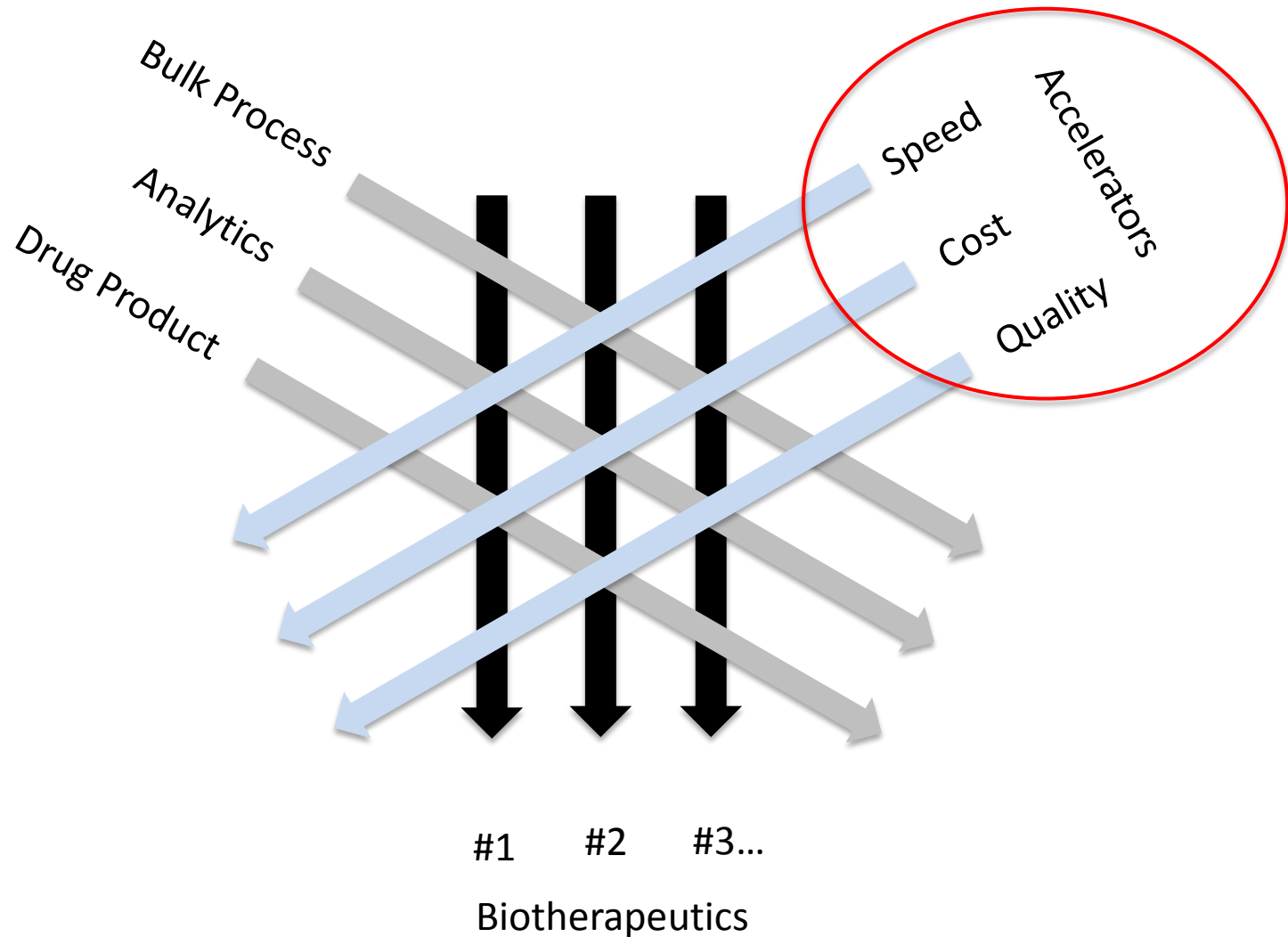


# Overall Objectives of Product Acceleration
