The AIChE Student Chapters Committee recognizes the excellent work being done by many student chapter advisors. We formally acknowledge the work done by these dedicated individuals by presentation of an Outstanding Student Chapter Advisor Award.

The attached nomination form may be used by an AIChE member or associate member to recommend an advisor for the award. Student Chapter members are qualified nominators.

The outstanding advisor will receive a cash award and a plaque. There will be only one person selected for the award each year, and once having won the award, that person is no longer eligible to receive it again for ten years. A list of past outstanding advisors is attached. The prize is generously supported by the Bartlesville, OK, AIChE Local Section and ConocoPhillips.

The advisor must have been advisor of a chartered AIChE student chapter for at least the last three years, and must have been an AIChE member during that time. The four terms discussed on this nomination form must be covered in detail. Any other supporting information will be considered in an evaluation and is strongly recommended. The absence of specific information fails to give the committee an adequate indication of the advisor's performance. As noted, **copies of the Chapter's last three annual reports are required.**

**Deadline & submissions:** Please consider whether your Student Chapter Advisor's performance is outstanding and respond accordingly. **Four copies** of all nominations should be sent to the address shown below and **must be postmarked no later than June 01, 2011**. (Note: E-mail submissions are allowed, but hardcopy is preferred, and the deadline for receipt is June 01.) This date is set so that the recipient can be properly recognized and included with all other AIChE awards at the Annual Meeting and National Student Conference. Since the Student Chapter's annual report for this current year may be not complete by this date, the three annual reports mentioned above would be those from 2007–2008, 2008–2009, and 2009–2010. This means that only those advisors who have completed three years before the start of the current academic year will be eligible. **Late submissions will not be considered.** Please direct any questions to the awards administrator at 646-495-1333 or [awards@aiiche.org](mailto:awards@aiiche.org).
