

Sustainable Engineering Forum Industrial Practice Award

This award recognizes individuals or teams who have made outstanding contributions over a long-term basis pertinent to sustainable engineering development in the practice of industrial chemical process, product design or manufacturing.

Deadline for Receiving Nominations: June 15, 2021

Award Administrator: Sustainable Engineering Forum (SEF)

Award: The Awardee will receive a plaque and \$1,000

Instruction: The applicant's achievements will be demonstrated by both publications (articles, patents, and internal reports) and reputation in the field of sustainable engineering. A nomination package should include one nomination letter and three support letters. The selection of the awardee will be based on their continued contributions to the development, implementation and dissemination of sustainable engineering practice in the chemical process industry and related fields. Contributions may include paradigms for sustainable development and/or general application of new practices. The Awardee need not necessarily be a chemical engineer. The applicant or at least one member of the team must be a member of AIChE and Sustainable Engineering Forum at the time of application.

Presentation: The Award will be presented during the AIChE Annual National Meeting. The awardee may be invited to present a paper at a SEF plenary session.
