

Sustainable Engineering Forum Student Paper Award

Award is presented to up to three full-time undergraduate or graduate students per year who prepare the best technical papers that describe results related to engineering and sustainability.

Deadline for Receiving Nominations: June 15, 2021

Award Administrator: Sustainable Engineering Forum (SEF)

Award: Student Award recipients will receive \$500 for travel expenses associated with attending the AIChE annual meeting, plus a certificate of recognition.

Instruction: Each nominee will be judged primarily based on the significance of his/her journal publication in the field of sustainable engineering. A nomination should include one nomination letter and one support letter. A nomination package should include a copy of the paper. The selection criteria are: (1) Technical merit: The student(s) needs to provide original experimental data and/or published facts; (2) Quality: The student(s) should have the paper published (or accepted) in a refereed journal within the last two years. (3) Results: The content of the paper needs to describe significant results; (4) Authorship: The student needs to be the primary author; (5) Qualifications: Awardee must be a member of the AIChE and the SEF at the time of application. The awardee must enroll in an ABET accredited chemical engineering program.

Presentation: The Award will be presented during the AIChE Annual National Meeting. The awardee may be invited to present a paper at a SEF plenary session.
