1. Read anti-trust statement – Joe Lally
2. Discussed the 6th paper on oxygenates modeling from U of Ghent

Joe: Modeling can be academic.

Tom: Methanol in feed, refinery based feeds is of interest. One concern: Is there time for it? Main Committee liked the topic, better than others can drop one of the others. Tom said we are not comfortable with that.

Robert: Experimental, real data, need to stay away sales pitch.

Based on the discussion, all in attendance agreed it should be included. Once the minutes are published, we plan to inform U of Ghent they will be included in the session early next week.
