- Exothermic Runaway in Reactor Feed Heater (Sasol) (Abstract submitted for 2020)
- (New) Potential paper on Burner management or other safety items (Linde)
- (New) Furnace Reverse Flow Affecting Piping with lower MAWT (Eastman)
- (New) Potential paper on Ethylene Decomp in small bore piping (ExxonMobil)
- Detonations at Ground Flare (NOVA?/Sasol?/Joint?)
- Furnace Overtemperature Incident (Chevron Phillips)

- Mercury in Cold Boxes (ExxonMobil)
- Sasol Light ends fouling
- Nova (Jake) PQE Inlet Cone Failures
