The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:09 AM.

- I. Greetings and opening remarks

- V. Paper Topics/Abstracts Update: See spreadsheet for details
  - a. Jorge Blanco reported that all available abstracts are loaded and that several new abstracts had been submitted online.
  - b. Newly submitted abstracts were reviewed.
  - c. It was agreed to add the paper by Stefen Luijten (Dow) on "condition based recoiling" of furnaces, giving a total of 7 papers (and presentations) for the session.
  - d. It was recommended to transfer the newly submitted abstract on Big Data to the Technology subcommittee.
