Marcus introduced the leadership of the Division for 2019.

Approval of Minutes from Pittsburgh (Atanas Serbezov) A motion to approve the minutes as distributed by e-mail passed by acclamation.

Review of Action Items from Pittsburgh: 1- Division Funds Allocation for 2019 (Marcus Mello) Completed
