#### **COLLABORATION BEARS FRUIT: MGMT AND THE ACADEMY**

The Management Division seeks collaboration with divisions and groups recognizing that leaders are in many different roles and technical areas. The sharing of leadership practices across groups helps members find mentors and helps identify emerging needs. MGMT has a long history of collaboration with the Environmental Division and ChE & the Law Forum and is revamping collaborations with the Early Career Community.

In 2023, MGMT reached out to and began to collaborate with AIChE's Institute for Learning and Innovation (ILI) (https://www.aiche.org/ili). At that time, ILI was working on career development offerings as well as pulling together aspects of credentialing, best practices for internships, and incorporating content from the Academy. While several joint opportunities were discussed, it was agreed to have the initial focus on webinars that addressed subjects identified by a recent Academy survey. The first webinar, focused on Time Management, was approached as a pilot; feedback from participants was very positive. The collaboration showed the power of content on leadership development from the Management Division that can be used broadly across AIChE. The Academy brought a professional approach, format, and infrastructure that allowed access throughout AIChE.

MGMT and the Academy continue the collaboration with the next webinar scheduled for September 18, 2025, with a focus on career advancement. This webinar will feature Mark Vergnano, former CEO of Chemours.

In 2026, we hope to use feedback from a Management Division survey and further surveys from the Academy to guide expansion of the collaborations. Contact Dennis W. 
