



Thank you for scheduling your time to volunteer at Harvesters. Volunteers help sort and repackage food that feeds 66,000 people in our community every week. **Please share this important information regarding your upcoming visit with all members of your group.**

Directions & Parking

From I-70 Take Van Brunt Blvd. south (Van Brunt becomes Emanuel Cleaver II Blvd.), turn east (left) on Leeds Trafficway, turn right on Topping.

Heading south on I-435 - Take I-70 West to Van Brunt Blvd. Take Van Brunt south (Van Brunt becomes Emanuel Cleaver II Blvd.), turn east (left) on Leeds Trafficway, turn right on Topping.

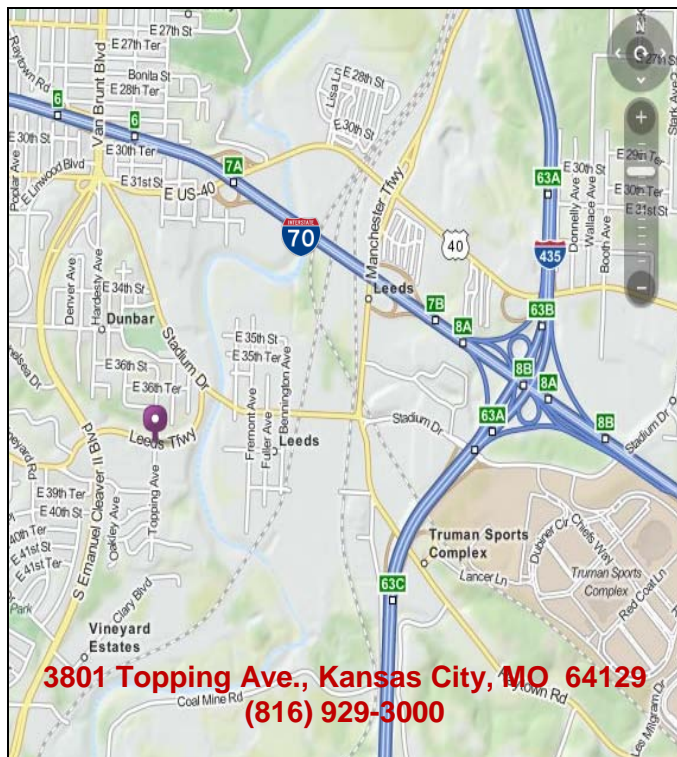
Heading north on I-435 - Take Stadium Drive west, turn left on Leeds Trafficway, turn left on Topping.

From 71 Highway - Take Emanuel Cleaver II Blvd. east, turn right on Leeds Trafficway, turn right on Topping.

Hiland Dairy (formerly Roberts Dairy) is located at the intersection of Emanuel Cleaver II and Leeds Trafficway. Harvesters is east of Roberts Dairy.

Parking is limited so please carpool. Visitor parking is available in front of the building and in an overflow lot across the street. Please do not block in Harvesters' trailers. If spots fill, please limit street parking to the east side so semi-trucks can safely access our facility.

Guest should enter through the Volunteer Entrance (under the red awning) located on the east side of the main entrance.



Important Information

- ✓ **Children under the age of 6 are not permitted in the warehouse for safety reasons.** Volunteers ages 6-15 require adult supervision.
- ✓ While volunteering, please be sure to closely supervise younger children in your group and others who need additional assistance.
- ✓ Please arrive promptly.
- ✓ Leave all valuables at home or in your vehicle.
- ✓ Water fountains are available. If you bring a water bottle, you will need to leave it in the Volunteer Breakroom.
- ✓ Hunger never stops so we make every effort to be open. If Harvesters does decide to close for inclement weather, we will post a voicemail message on our main phone line at 816-929-3000. If we are open and you chose to cancel, please let us know.
- ✓ Harvesters maintains a smoke-free campus.



Attire

- ✓ **Closed toed shoes are required.**
- ✓ Dress casually (jeans and t-shirts, and sweatshirts to layer in the winter)
- ✓ Keep jewelry to a minimum.
- ✓ Coat racks are available in the Volunteer Breakroom.



Warehouse Safety – Volunteers will be serving in an active warehouse. Harvesters abides by the following OSHA and AIB rules to ensure everyone's safety.

- ✓ **Cell phone usage is not permitted in the warehouse.**
- ✓ Ear buds/headphones are not permitted.
- ✓ No food or drink is allowed in the warehouse.
- ✓ Please do not walk under, climb or lean on shelving.
- ✓ Please do not stand or sit on pallets.
- ✓ Please do not run in the warehouse.

- ✓ Cereal – hot and cold
- ✓ Soap
- ✓ Shampoo
- ✓ Deodorant
