The Student Chapter of the University of Florida helps students familiarize themselves with the Chemical Engineering department of the Gainesville area.

In each semester, they usually make 2 visits to the water stations. Currently, a brewery tour is planned at a local company.

In addition, they promote fundraising events each semester, as well as the sale of merchandise, such as T-shirts. Therefore, it has several corporate sponsorships and companies that wish to hold informative sessions. Sponsors: Dow, Intel, P & G, Chevron, ExxonMobil and AIChE Central Florida Section.

The chapter also holds many social events throughout the semester. For example, welcome events week (1 event per day) to welcome new and old AIChE members and integrate them into the organization in a fun way.
