

Information This is a competition that requires a team of students to compete in many various

competitions in the areas of science and technology. There are 52 different events with 26 being run for the Middle School students and 26 for the High School students. Many of the events are highly interactive ranging from robots and bottle rockets to laboratory analysis and, of course, a few written tests. There were 46 different schools represented last year from 9 different counties with almost 700 students competing. Teams performing well can advance to the state

(in April) and even national (in May) competitions.

January's Meeting in Review

Color Matching & Small Scale Manufacturing

A group of about 17 people toured A. Schulman in Sharon Center on January 16th. The tour included a brief slide show presentation. A. Schulman is an international supplier of high performance plastic compounds with headquarters in Akron. At the color facility in Wadsworth, the lab can do over 1500 color matches a year. A color match involves matching a recipe to a color that the customer sends in. The color to be matched may be from a magazine ad, article of clothing, etc.

Schulman matches the color using proprietary color matching software and trial runs on bench scale equipment. The software gives them a starting recipe for the color. Then a sample is prepared and its color properties measured. After comparing the test sample to the required sample, the recipe is altered. This sequence repeats until the match is made.

The bench scale equipment we saw was single screw extruder, twin screw extruder, mixer and a small rotational molder. They were extruding blue and black polymers for the tour. The polymers are loaded with color concentrate in the extruder and then pelletized. This product is sometimes called a masterbatch. Then the customer uses a very small amount of the masterbatch for coloring their products.

They did a color match demonstration from a bright yellow paper from someone on the tour. The paper was placed on the computer and analyzed for color properties using a spectrophotometer. Then the program gave back a sample color from their color library. The library sample exactly matched the test paper. The group was impressed with the match.

We also saw the different effects on the perceived color of an object from different lighting mediums. The lab machine produced light similar to natural light, fluorescent light and night light. A "green" tie varied in color from gray to green to brown depending on the light. This phenomenon is called metamerism. Their color matching method accounts for this effect.

After the excellent tour, the group had dinner at the Galaxy restaurant.
