May Section Meeting: Presentation and Tour of National Renewable Energy Laboratory National Bioenergy Center

The National Bioenergy Center (NBC) at the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL) is focused on developing biomass to fuel technologies. The Thermochemical Process Development Unit (TCPDU) is a 0.5 ton per day pilot plant, which is used to demonstrate different thermochemical conversion technologies developed at the bench scale. The thermochemical platform uses heat and catalysts to convert biomass, such as wood, corn stover, and switch grass, into valuable fuels and chemicals. There are multiple conversion pathways being explored, including gasification, fast pyrolysis, and ex-situ pyrolysis.



Esther Wilcox is a principle investigator and manager at the National Renewable Energy Lab researching pilot-scale thermochemical conversion of cellulosic biomass to liquid fuels. She has over 10 years of experience in alternative energy research with a strong background in catalysis and kinetics. Esther obtained her B.S. in chemical engineering from the University of Tulsa and M.S. and Ph.D. in chemical engineering from North Carolina State University.


