Take I-40 east from Raleigh toward Smithfield and continue to Hwy 70 East. Continue for 9.5 miles through Clayton. Grifols is on the left side of the highway. Turn at the stop light just before the parking lots, Natvar will be on the left. Drive straight and follow the signs for D310 (you will pass the first employee entrance) and cross the RR tracks and stop at the guard house. The guard will direct you to gravel parking lot north of the new building. Enter the front entrance to D310.
