Humacyte is a privately held company that develops novel human tissue-based investigational products that are being developed for potential commercialization for key applications in regenerative medicine and vascular surgery. The Company uses a proprietary technology platform to isolate and grow investigational human acellular vessels (HAV) that have the potential, subject to further evaluation and regulatory review, to provide stable, "off-the shelf" human tissue replacements to pre-designed clinical and commercial specifications. The initial application will be for vascular access in patients with End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD). Humacyte's Humacyl™, a human acellular vessel, earned FDA fast-track status in 2014 for vascular access in dialysis patients.

Ted Lithgow is the Chief Operating Officer for Humacyte, Inc., located in the Research Triangle. Ted is a psychopharmacologist and trained at The City University of New York and Albert Einstein College of Medicine in Bronx, New York. Ted was formerly President and Chief Science Officer of Meadwestvaco Corporation Healthcare Strategic Business Unit and a member of the corporation's Operating Council, with key responsibilities for leading marketing, portfolio development, commercialization of new products, regulatory affairs and quality assurance, and adjacent market development initiatives. He has held variations positions in the pharmaceutical industry, including at Schering Plough/Merck, Pharmacia Corporation, and Wyeth.
