If you are interested in getting more involved, please reach out to anyone on the executive committee. There are many ways you can help and be creative especially during




this time when in-person activities are limited. We hope to see you at our various activities this season as we continue to learn via our virtual seminar series. I look forward to yet another great year.




Past chair Stacie Santhany passing the gavel to Deboleena Chakraborty while maintaining distance


