TOPIC COMPARISON SURVEY CONCLUSIONS:

- 1 CLE AICHE Section in general is actively participating in same or similar topics as other AICHE Local Sections similar in size or larger.
- 2 CLE AICHE Section is least active in the TOUR (0.1) area of sectional comparisons.
- 3 CLE AICHE Section is next least active in the SOCIAL (0.25) CAREER (0.2) and ENERGY (0.2) areas of sectional comparisons.
- 4 CLE AICHE Section is best active in the STEM (0.5), SAFETY (0.4) and YP's (0.43) areas of sectional comparisons. All good areas!
- 5 CLE AICHE Section is next best active in the ENVIRONMENT (0.33), SEMINAR (0.38), and Planning (0.33) areas of sectional comparisons. Good areas!

RECOMMENDATIONS FROM TOPIC COMPARISON SURVEY CONCLUSIONS:

- 1 CLE AICHE Section may consider adding a section recognition awards event for CSU & CWRU Students; Young Professionals, & Members
- 2 CLE AICHE Section may consider adding more tours to the annual events. Possibly best done during the summer months.
- 3. CLE AICHE Section may consider adding more seminars to fund any check for recognition awards to local section from Item # 1 above.
 - a. We can evaluate how profitable our safety and simulation seminars were to best evaluate their future funding capacity.
 - b. We can explore selling newsletter advertising space to local industry for an added income stream as in past years.
 - We can explore local industry buying advertising tables at our local monthly meetings.
 - d. We can explore local industry making a cash donation towards CLE AICHE NEOSEF and CSU / CWRU Awards.
