Rise of the near August Sturgeon Moon over the Cuyahoga River!



The August full moon, also known as the Sturgeon Moon, will be visible on August 9th, 2025, with peak illumination occurring on August 10th. This name comes from the large sturgeon fish that were historically abundant in the Great Lakes and other major bodies of water during this time of year, making them easier to catch. The Sturgeon Moon is also associated with the start of the harvesting season and can be referred to as the Corn Moon, Harvest Moon, or Flying Up Moon.

Date and Time:

The Sturgeon Moon will be visible on Saturday, August 9th, with peak illumination on Sunday, August 10th at 1:55 PM EST.

Name Origin:


The name "Sturgeon Moon" is attributed to the abundance of sturgeon fish in the Great Lakes and other bodies of water during this time of year, making them a significant food source for Native American tribes.


