

- Presented in recognition of an individual's or a group of individual's efforts and achievements in behalf of or the advancement the Science of Chemical Engineering as part of the South Texas Section's "programming committee activity".
- This Award may be presented outside of the "Programming Committee" Function at the direction of the South Texas Section (STS) Executive Committee.
- This award is not an "annual" award and cannot be presented more than once a year. *(This award should not be presented multiple times in a year for different achievements unless unique circumstances exist such as the proposed recipient moving out of the area or known to be suffering from a terminal illness.)*
- Recipient selected by Chair-Elect with agreement of Chair & Past-Chair. *(If unanimous agreement is not obtained, the STS Executive Committee will decide.)*
- Recipient does not have to be a member of the South Texas Section or of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers.
- The South Texas Section Academic Achievement Award consists of an appropriate STS-AIChE Award Plaque with award name, recipient's name, & date (year) inscribed on it.
