Chemical Engineering Practice Achievement Award

The South Texas Section Chemical Engineering Practice Achievement Award is a special award to be given at the pleasure of the South Texas Section Executive Committee in recognition of an individual's or a group of individual's efforts and achievements in behalf of or the advancement the Science of Chemical Engineering. This award is not an "annual" award and the recipient does not have to be a member of the South Texas Section (STS) of AIChE or the American Institute of Chemical Engineers.

Only one South Texas Section Chemical Engineering Practice Achievement Award may be presented per year unless the STS Executive Committee decides otherwise. *(The award should not be presented multiple times in a year for different achievements unless unique circumstances exist such as the propose recipient moving out of the area or known to be suffering from a terminal illness.)*

This award may be presented by the STS's Chair-Elect as part of the STS' "Program Committee" Function provided there is unanimous agreement by the STS Chair and STS Past-Chair. If either the Chair or Past-Chair disagrees, the decision to award must be approved by the STS Executive Committee. These Awards may be presented outside of the "Programming Committee" Function at the direction of the STS Executive Committee.

The award will consist of an appropriate STS – AIChE plaque with the name of the award, the recipient's name, and date (year) presented inscribed on it.
