February 20, 2020 Meeting

We are proud to welcome Ms. Jessica Astoria, Director of Engineering with Comi Polaris Systems, Inc. located in Charlotte.

Ms. Astoria is a long time section member, a registered professional engineer, and you may remember her previous work with LCI Corporation, or Chemtex International. She has a BS in Chemical Engineering from NCSU.

Comi Polaris specializes in customized separation technologies, offering filtering centrifuges; filter and vacuum dryers; and VOC / solvent recovery systems. The topic she will be speaking on is Cryogenic Condensation and Vapor Recovery.

Cryogenic Condensation separates volatile organic compounds (VOC) from vent gases by using liquid nitrogen to cool a vent gas stream, therefore lowering the vapor pressure of the VOC in the stream while condensing them. Due to the low operating temperature, compounds can be separated into solid frosts, depending on the combination of the melting point and vapor pressure equilibrium curves allowing plants to achieve VOC abetment goals with the nondestructive advantage of nitrogen and solvent recycling.

We also have a technical paper and summary brochure that I will be happy to e-mail to interested members.
