


Logging In/Nickname

- Members must be logged into the AIChE website to access the Forums/Web Community.
- Then go to http://www.aiche.org/MemberCenter/ForumCommunity.aspx
- The first time entering the forum the member must set up their Nickname. This Nickname will appear besides all comments and correspondence. This can be achieved by: (There is a quick link to this in the member center)
 - Clicking on the link Please <u>Click Here To Change Your Forum</u>
 <u>Nickname</u> to the right direct right of the AIChE Logo.
 Or
 - Click on *Control Panel* and then in the left panel, select *Registration Details* in the Your Profile Block.
 - o Here the member should enter their nick name and they are ready to go.




Add a Topic

- Select Add Topic Top Left






Subscribe to a Forum or Topic




Display Mode: Flat or Threaded Topic Views

 - o Threaded






Add a Poll




• Select **Calendar** in the top right of the screen.
