# How to respectfully "Pronoun"?

## How to Pronoun:

#### **1. Share your pronouns during intro**

- "Suzy she/her" (keep it simple!)
- "Hello, I'm Ben, and my pronouns are they/them".
  - Do not say: "OBVIOUSLY my pronouns are..." it is not obvious. This is which is why we do it.

### **2.** Invite others to share their pronouns

• "What pronouns do you use?"

### 3. Use the correct pronouns

- If you make a mistake, apologize and continue
- Use positive reinforcement with the correct pronouns if mistake occurred by others
  - Example: a person says, "he had a great talk", you can say "yes, THEY did have a great talk"

## **Helpful tips:**

#### Avoid Assumptions:

• Don't assume someone's pronouns based on their appearance or gender expression.

### Use Gender-Neutral Language:

• When referring to a group of people, use inclusive language like "everyone" or "people" instead of "guys" or "ladies".

#### • Be Open to Learning:

- If you are unsure about someone's pronouns, ask them respectfully and be open to learning.
- Remember that pronouns are not suggestions, they are inherent to who we are.
