This award recognizes individuals or teams who have made outstanding contributions over a long-term basis pertinent to sustainable engineering development in the practice of industrial chemical process, product design or manufacturing.

Award:

The Awardee will receive a plaque and \$2,500.

Presentation:

The Award will be presented at the Sustainable Engineering Forum luncheon during the AIChE Annual National Meeting. The Forum may offer to present the award at a SEF plenary session.

Instructions:

The applicant's achievements will be based on both publications (articles, patents, and internal reports) and reputation substantiated by at least three (3) written recommendations. The selection of the Awardee for a given year will be based on their continued contributions to the development, implementation and dissemination of sustainable engineering practice in the chemical process industry and related fields. Contributions may include paradigms for sustainable development and/or general application of new practices. The Awardee need not necessarily be a chemical engineer. The applicant or at least one member of the team must be a member of AIChE as well as Sustainable Engineering Forum at the time of application.
