Deadline for Receiving Nominations:

May 31, 2019

Award Administrator(s):

Award:

The Awardee will receive \$1,000 and a plaque.

Presentation:

The Award will be presented at the Sustainable Engineering Forum luncheon during the AIChE Annual National Meeting. The Forum may offer to present the award at a SEF plenary session.

Instructions:

The applicant's achievements will be based on both publications and reputation substantiated by at least two (2) written recommendations. Emphasis should be placed on accomplishments and advances made within the last five years, although the award can also be made to someone who has had an outstanding career. The Awardee need not necessarily be a chemical engineer. The applicant ~~or at least one member of the team~~ must be a member of AIChE as well as Sustainable Engineering Forum at the time of application. The recipient shall have a considerable record of service in the activities of the Sustainable Engineering Forum.
