Please send your draft presentation in PowerPoint format to the session chairs via email for review. **All final presentations need to be sent to session chairs with a copy (CC) to ccpseuropeanconference@aiche.org by October 18, 2023.** All ppt presentations will be made available for conference attendees as conference proceedings.

If internal company technical and/or legal reviews are required by your employer, plan accordingly and prepare your work well in advance so that you are able to meet the deadlines.

- ✓ Presentation will need to be submitted in PowerPoint Format

Review comments will be forwarded to and/or discussed with presenters for inclusion in the final technical presentation.
