


Creating a second profile can result in problems going forward.

If you know your login/password, log in here and proceed to your profile. The "Professional" section will need to be updated with your Syngenta information.


In the Company field, begin typing "Syngenta" and select "Syngenta Basel Switzerland" from the drop-down list. This will be the first selection.

New Users


If you're a new user, go to www.aiche.org/ccps

In the **Organization/Company** field, begin typing "Syngenta" and **select "Syngenta Basel Switzerland" from the drop-down list** in order to Checkout free. The Primary Address section will auto-populate with the selected employer's address.

Just typing the name "Syngenta" WILL NOT let you obtain the courses free of charge.


YOU MUST select "Syngenta Basel Switzerland" from the drop-down list. This will be the first company on the drop-down list!



Accessing a Course


Once your account is set up, you are ready to access eligible courses from this program. When you are ready to begin a course, go to the Syngenta Course Offerings webpage for easy access to the course list and other resources.

After selecting a course, click CHECKOUT to get the course free.



NOTE: All courses on the Syngenta webpage are free for Syngenta employees. If your account is not recognizing you as such, please contact customerservice@aiche.org.


After completing the checkout process, your course will now show in your "My Purchases" section of the Academy website. You can also return to the course and click "Access Course"



You will be brought to a webpage that will contain a list of all the content you are able to access. Simply click on your course and you will be brought to your current / recent training. After selecting the course, you will be able to begin.

NOTE: You may need to log-in again after selecting a course if you have cleared your cache. Login again to be taken to your current training.

NOTE: Please be sure to turn off your ad-blocker / pop-up blocker. If you are having trouble understanding how to navigate through the course, the AIChE Navigation video provides an overview of how the content works.



You'll be able to adjust what courses you can see and in what order using the filters in the "Course Overview"

Once you complete a course **and the course evaluation**, you can access your PDH/CEU certificate when visiting the "Certificate" section of the course. You will also receive an email with the certificate.
