

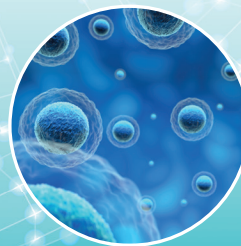
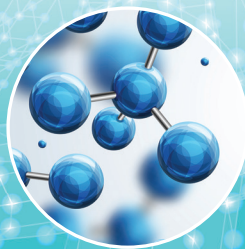


# Epigenetics & Bioengineering Conference
