Therefore, all participants, including speakers (invited or accepted through the Call for Abstracts), are expected to register and pay the appropriate registration fee.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations called in at 800.242.4363 or emailed to customerservice@aiche.org no later than 2 weeks prior to meeting start date, 11:59pm ET will receive a full refund less \$50 in processing charges. After 2 weeks prior to meeting start date no full registration refunds will be given. If you register but are unable to attend, AIChE will accept a substitute with a \$50 processing fee.
