

Tuas Waste-To-Energy Plant Tour

Tuas South Incineration Plant is the fourth and largest refuse incineration plant in Singapore. The plant is sited on 10.5 ha of reclaimed land and enables all incinerable waste generated in Singapore to be disposed of by incineration. The Plant was built with state-of-the-art technology. The various processes are highly automated and controlled via a digital control system. Incineration achieves about 90% reduction in volume of the refuse. Hence, all incinerable refuse are disposed of at the incineration plants while non incinerable refuse and ash from the incineration plants are disposed of at the Semakau Landfill.
